



Parking & Metro Info

There is a garage in the 20 F Building, however, there is a limited number of spots, about 10 available for day parkers. The fee is \$10.00 for an hour and \$21.00 for the day. The garage is located off of E Street. To get there drive past 20 F and make a right onto North Capital Street, then a right onto E Street. There is an alleyway on the right after the Hotel George. Turn into it and proceed until it dead-ends. The parking garage is on the right. If this garage is full, there is another one across E Street that is easily visible when you come back out of the alley. Below is a list to other parking garages located near the conference center:

Also, there are pay to park spots located on all the streets that surround the conference center. They are available to park at 7 days a week but you must pay for them at a pay to park machine between the hours of 6:00am–10:00pm.

We are located close to the Union Station metro. Here is a map to help show how to get here <http://www.20fstreetcc.com/location> but when exiting Union Station you go right out the main door, cross over 1st street taking Massachusetts for one block. At the corner where the Postal Museum is turn left on North Capitol and then turn right onto F Street. You will see the Irish Times Restaurant and we are right next to it at the building with 20F on it.

For those taking taxis please let them know to ask for 20 F Street, NW by Union Station. We have had problems with cab drivers taking people to 20 & F Street which is on the other side of town.
